Chapter I

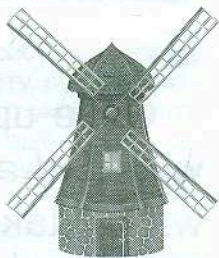

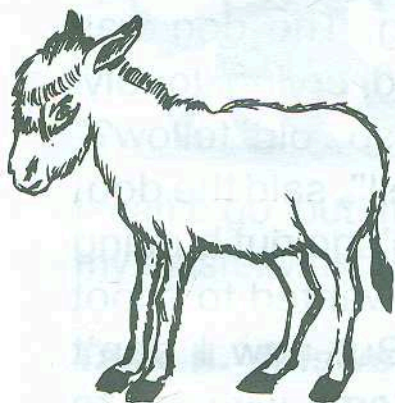

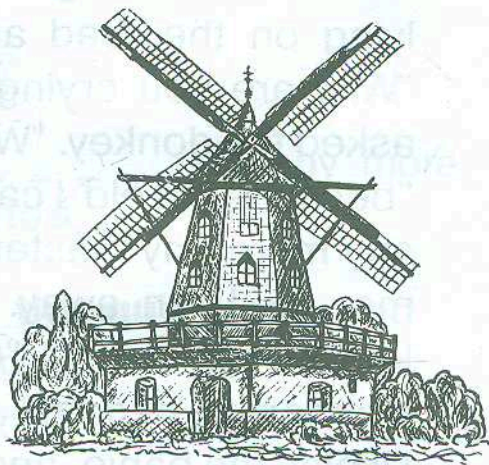
