The giant is mad.

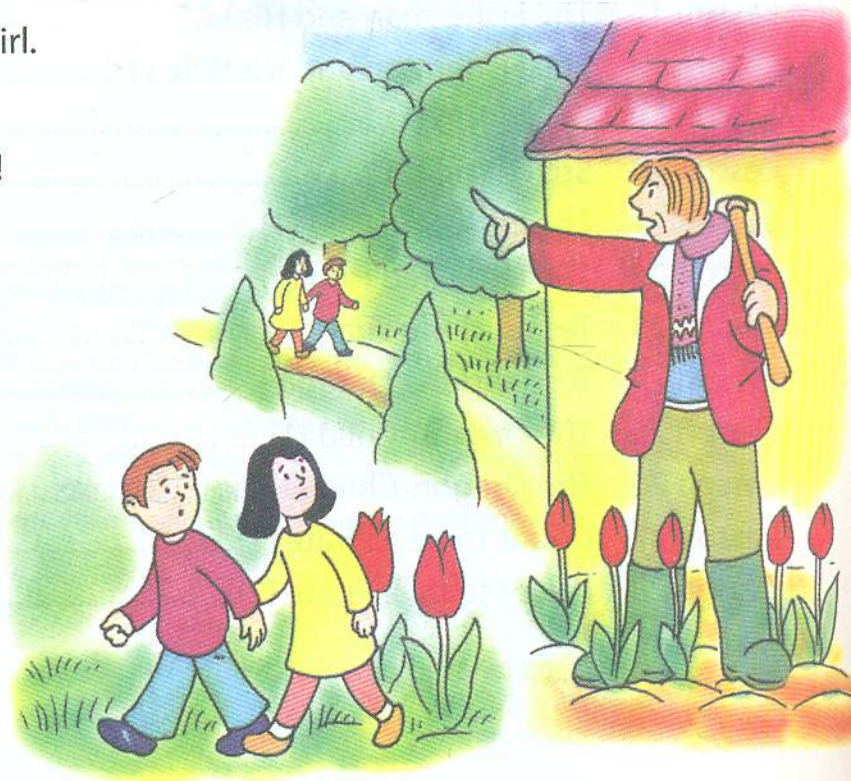
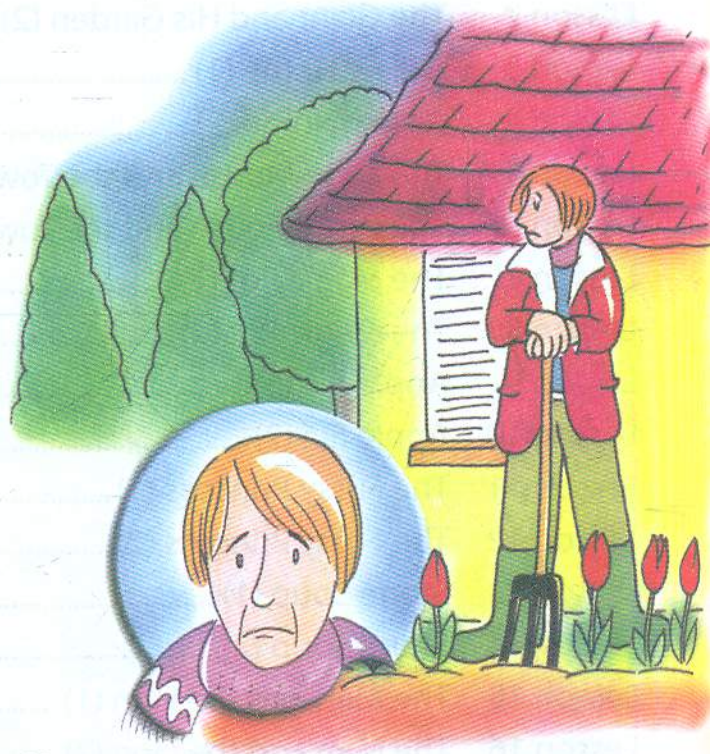
The giant says, "This is my house!

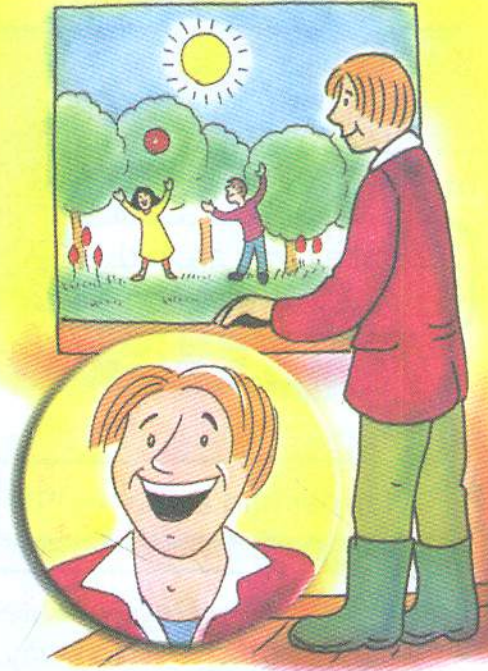

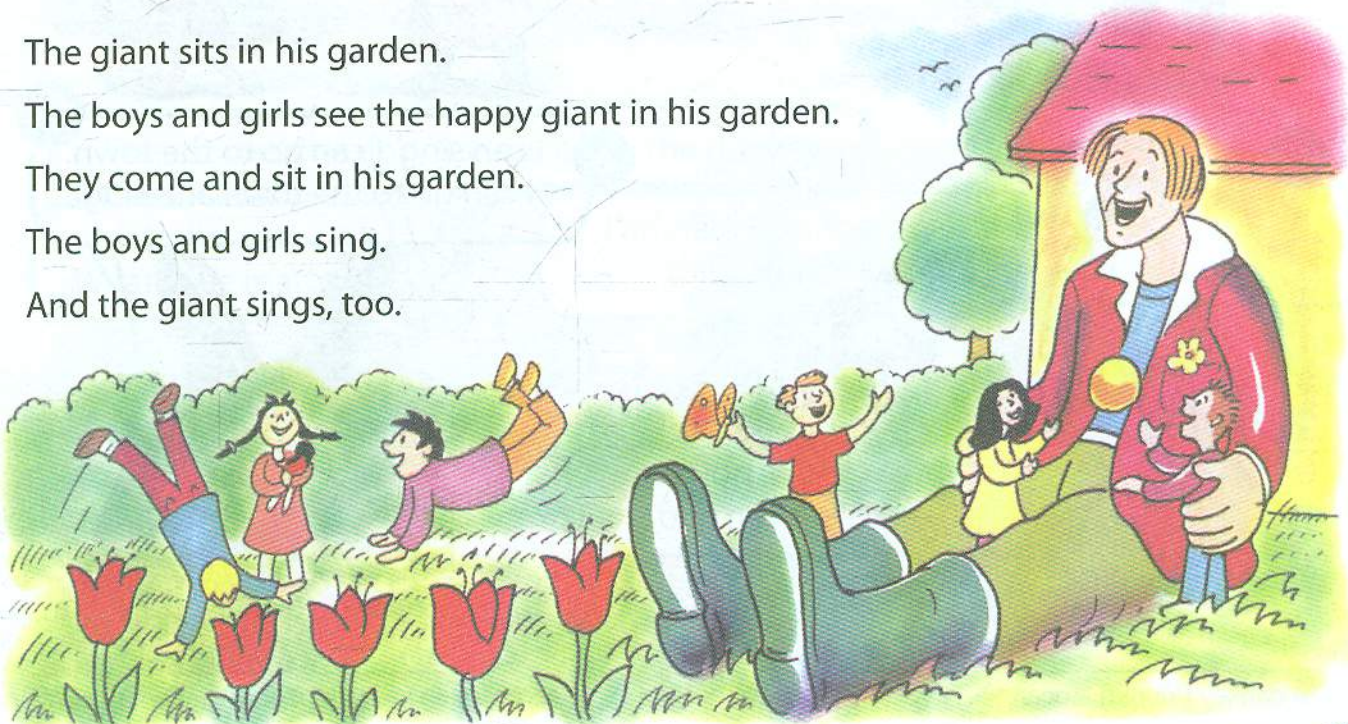
Lesson 2 The Giant and His Garden (2)

He has friends. He is happy.



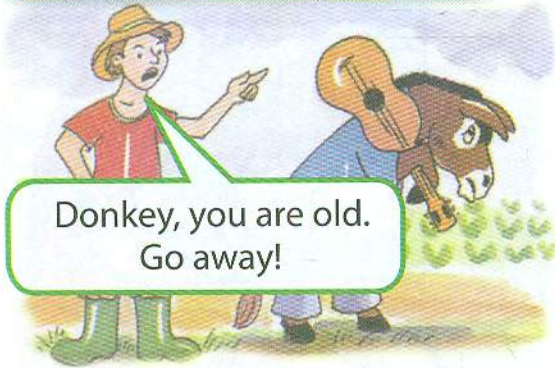
The giant sits in his garden.

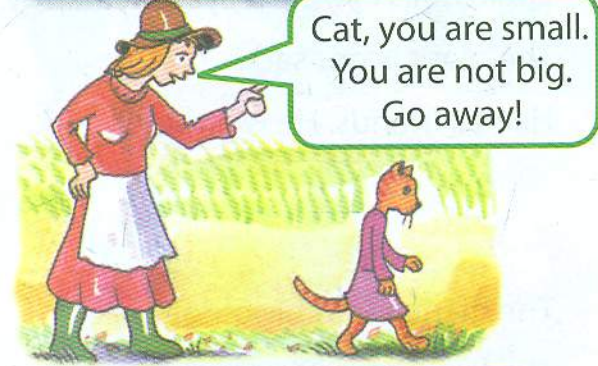
A farmer had a dog.

Go away!

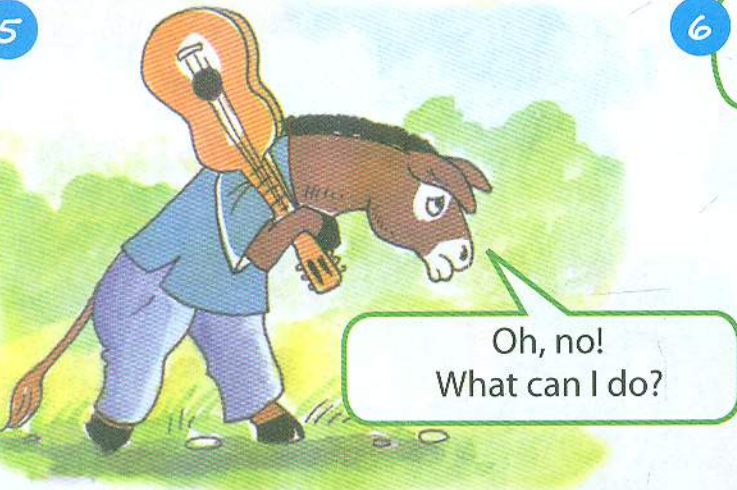

Go away!

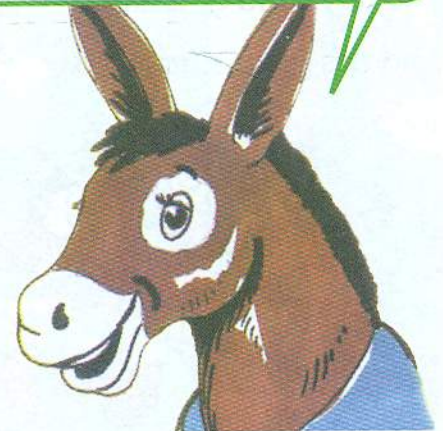

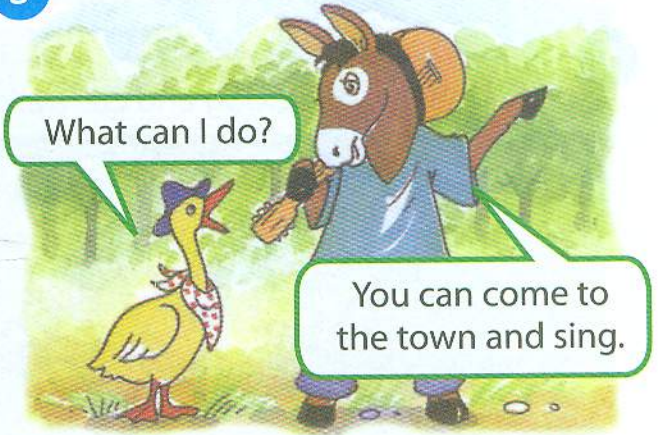
